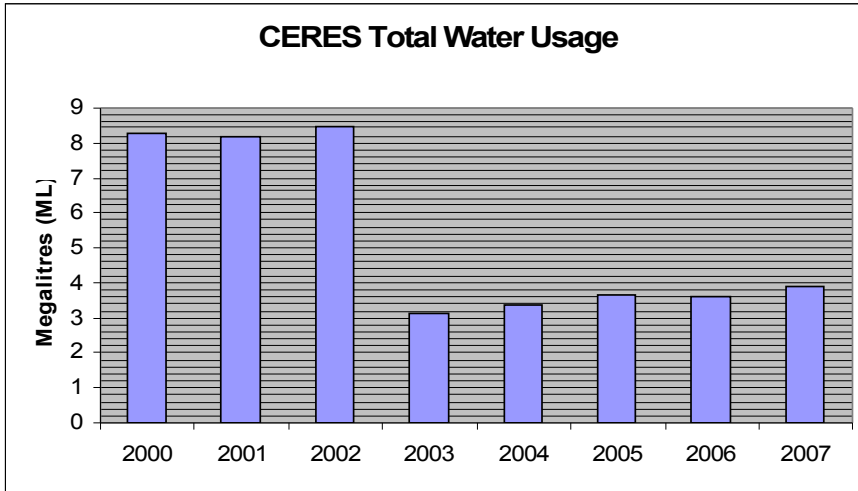




CERES Lee St whole-site meter recorded a total of 3884.50 kL mains water usage in 2007...

... that's **3.88 megalitres**.

This is an increase on 2006, however it's still less than half of our 2002 water usage (8.4 ML), before major water saving initiatives were put in place.
